How to create your IdHAL?

Login using your HAL user account

In the blue banner, click on « My IdHAL »



#### Choose your IdHAL

By default, it's in the form of first name-last name, but you can choose something else.



Once you've made your choice, you won't be able to change it.

Your different author forms (the forms in which your name appears in publications) are automatically retrieved, but you can add or delete them.

The "preferred form" will be the form proposed by default when submitting to HAL.

In the next step, click on See publications with your authors forms 📀

Associate with your IdHAL those publications of which you are the author (watch out for homonyms!)

If you are missing publications that are nevertheless deposited in HAL, in the list, use the button

🔍 Search

After that, publications deposited by your co-authors will be correctly linked to your IdHAL --> Frequently check your IdHAL and reattach your others authors forms and missing publications
