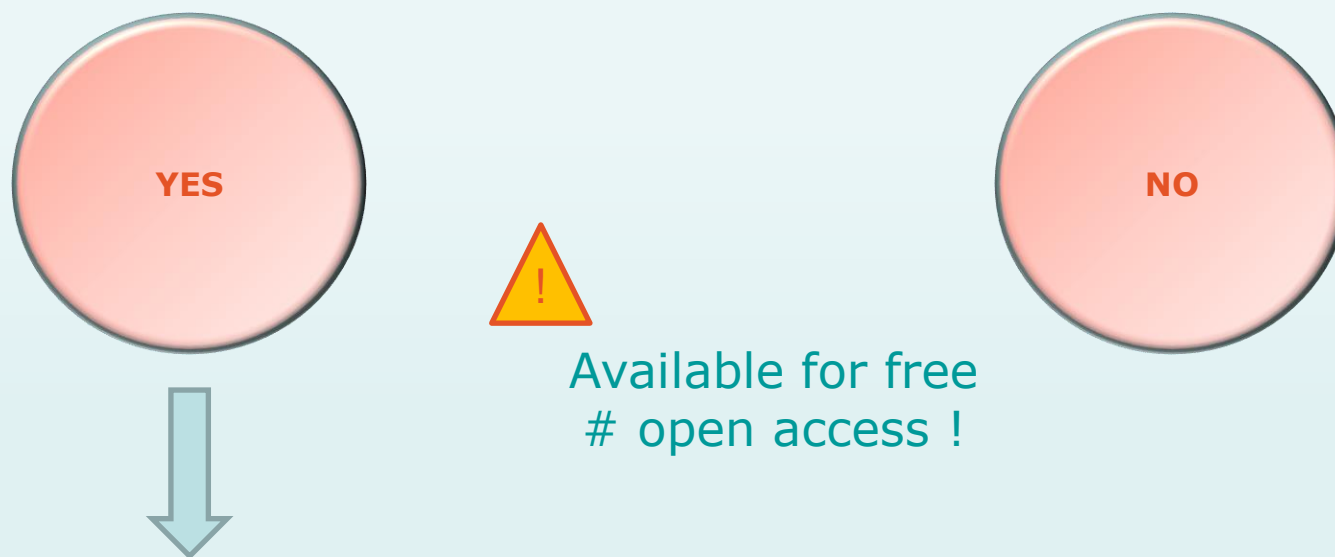

# Recognizing an open access article



## Available for free # open access !

Some articles are available for free (free access) without being freely reusable (open access). Free access articles, unlike open access articles, cannot be deposited in HAL in their publisher's version. I will need to deposit an author's version.

## How to determine if my article is in open access ?

It includes in this case a mention « open » or « open access » or [Creative commons licence](#) (CC-BY, CC-BY-NC, etc). **Examples :**



This is an open access article under the CC BY-NC-ND license



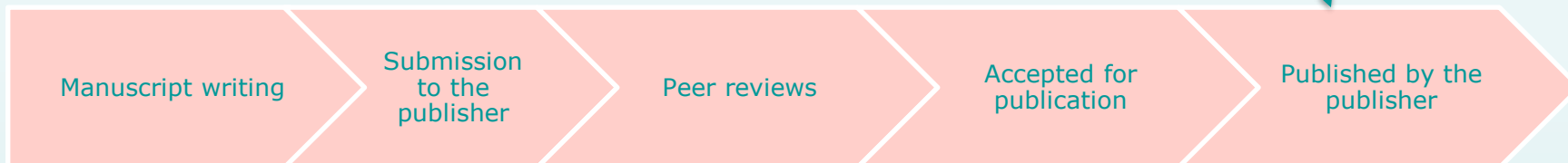

# I can submit the **editor version** of my article !

=

From its publication in [open access](#), I can upload the publisher's formatted version of my article to HAL (sometimes called a « PDF editor »)



I can submit my **author manuscript accepted for publication** in HAL without delay thanks to the Law for a Digital Republic \*



Accepted manuscript  $\neq$  publisher's version :  
What is an accepted manuscript ?

This law takes precedence over contracts signed with publishers !



*\* according to my answers to the previous questionnaire and provided that my research is not financed to more than 50% by private funds (taking salaries into account in the calculation).*

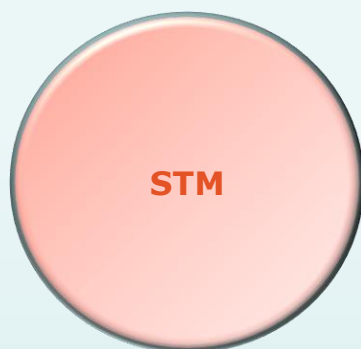

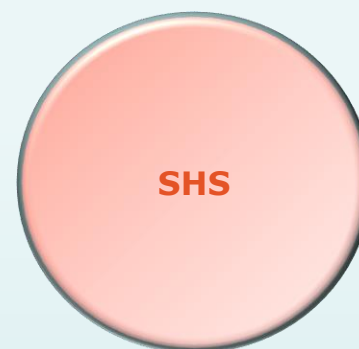

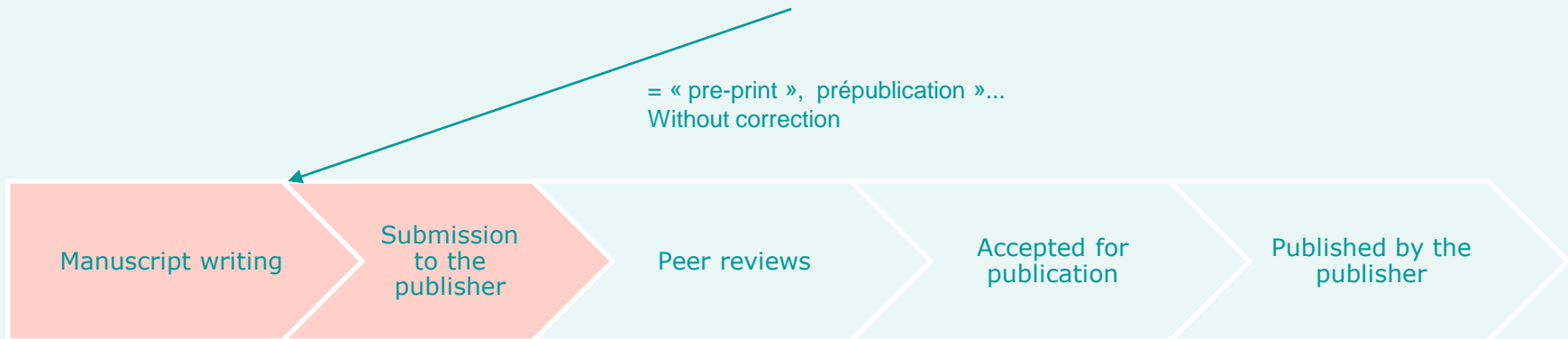
